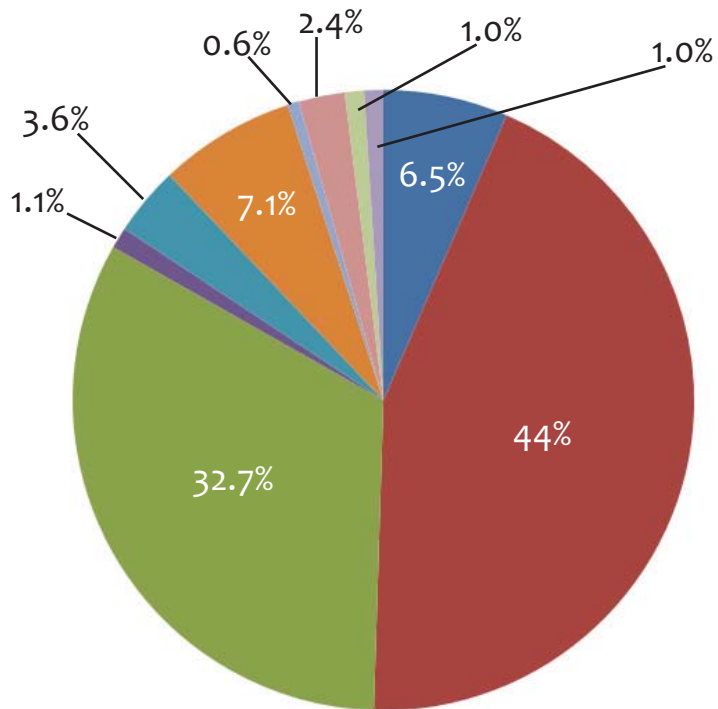

# Our Programs & Services

## *Food Bank*

Food banking has a simple purpose – to prevent the waste of good usable food and non-food products, and to channel those products through organizations that serve hungry people.

God's Pantry Food Bank acts as a clearinghouse for surplus, improperly weighed, cosmetically imperfect and about-to-expire food and non-food products from local, regional and national donors. These products are distributed to private, non-profit organizations with on-site feeding and emergency food box programs that serve the needy, young, ill, elderly and handicapped.

Food banking allows recipient organizations to get food and non-food items for pennies on the dollar. Each organization contributes a handling fee of up to 19 cents per pound for product from the food bank. This contribution helps pay part of the cost of obtaining, transporting, warehousing and distributing the product. God's Pantry Food Bank covers the remainder of the cost through donations from individuals, churches and businesses.



## *Fayette County Emergency Food Box Program*

The Fayette County Emergency Food Box Program serves clients directly through the distribution of a seven-day supply of food to an average of 1,650 households each month.

Those in need of assistance are referred by 220 local churches and social service agencies to one of our five neighborhood food pantries. An individual may receive a food box up to four times within a six-month period.

In FY 2010, more than 19,700 families were served by the Emergency Food Box Program in Fayette County.

## *Programs for Our Vulnerable Neighbors*

### *Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)*

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) works to improve the health of elderly people at least 60 years of age by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA commodity foods such as grain and milk products, protein, fruits and vegetables.

These seniors have monthly incomes less than 130% of the poverty

level. The food bank was able to increase its monthly caseload to 8,700 clients a month in 49 counties late in FY 2010. **Last year, more than 2.7 million pounds of food was distributed to seniors through the Commodity Supplemental Food Program.**

### *Kids Cafe*

The mission of the Kids Cafe program is to help alleviate child hunger in America by providing hungry children with nutritious meals at times when other resources are not available, such as after school. Kids Cafe programs provide free meals and snacks to low-income children through a variety of existing community locations where children congregate such as community centers, churches or public schools. In addition to providing meals to hungry kids, all Kids Cafe locations also offer a safe place, where under

the supervision of caring staff, a child can get involved in educational, recreational and social activities.

God's Pantry Food Bank currently operates 10 Kids Cafe programs and last year served more than 29,400 meals to the children at these sites.



### *The Backpack Program*

There are many children in America that rely on free or reduced-priced school lunch during the school year. The Backpack Program is designed to meet the needs of hungry children at times when other resources are not available, such as weekends and school vacations.

- Backpacks are filled with food that children take home on weekends.
- All of the food is child-friendly, nonperishable, easily consumed and vitamin fortified.
- Backpacks are discreetly distributed to children on the last day before the weekend or holiday breaks.

In FY 2010, more than 17,500 Backpacks were distributed through the food bank's sites.

# The Year In Review

- God's Pantry Food Bank distributed **17.8 million pounds of food** in Fiscal Year 2010.
- The food bank released the results of its intense research project, Hunger in Central and Eastern Kentucky 2010, revealing it provided food to more than **211,000** people in 2009. That represents **1 in 7** people living in the 50-county service area.
- The food bank was able to relieve some space limitations by purchasing a **46,000 square foot** receiving warehouse in nearby Winchester.
- More than **6,500** volunteers donated **19,685** hours of service to the food bank in FY 2010.



God's Pantry Food Bank serves 50 counties of Central and Eastern Kentucky through a network of more than 320 non-profit member agencies.

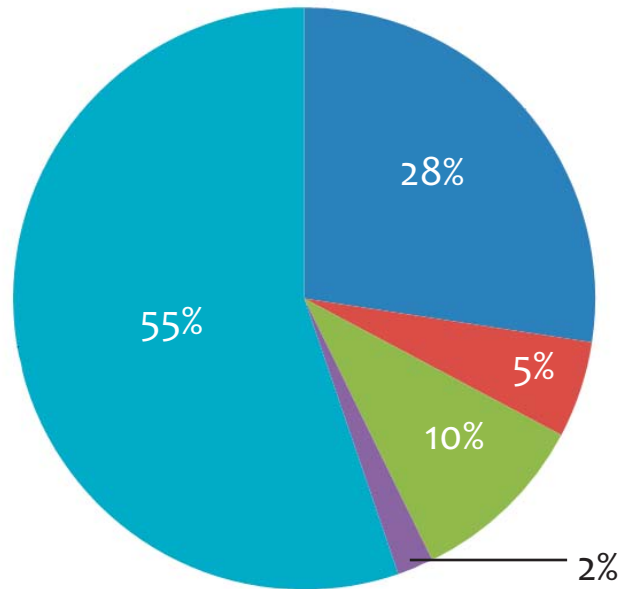
