Dear Friends,

It's January 2009 and 2008 already seems like a blur! I am pleased to share with you this report on our activities over the period of July 1, 2007–June 30, 2008. It was a challenging but rewarding year and we are grateful for your support as we diligently work every day to achieve our mission of reducing hunger in Kentucky.

Our supply and demand sides both experienced challenges; demand for emergency food services increased, while transportation and food costs also went up dramatically. Still, we were able to distribute more than 15 million pounds of food and grocery products to our member agencies and individuals in need, a 16% increase over the previous year. Further, we were able to increase our deliveries to our 350-plus member agencies throughout our 50-county service area by 38%. Increasing our level of service to all of our clients in these tough times was no small feat, so we are proud to share this success with you.

We know there are segments of the population we serve who are especially at risk for hunger. Feeding children through our Kids Cafe program is an extremely rewarding endeavor. Over the past year we served 24,000 meals at seven sites in three counties. Our Mobile Pantry Program, which targets underserved counties, continues to be an effective catalyst for the creation of pantries in areas without a consistent source of emergency food assistance. Our Commodity Supplemental Food Program serves the senior population and last year provided in excess of 2 million pounds of food to low-income individuals.

At God's Pantry Food Bank we are working harder than ever to keep up with the dramatically increasing demand for assistance from people and agencies across our 50-county service area. The months ahead will bring some tough challenges as well as exciting developments for our organization, our member agencies, and our supporters.

Our main challenge is to be able to meet the demand of providing sufficient food to our member agencies at a time when they are seeing requests for food assistance grow. We are all working conscientiously at God's Pantry to meet that significant need by securing enough food and financial donations to keep our agencies well supplied. As we face a cold winter and higher costs across the board, we are conscious of taking advantage of all available resources.

It is important to note that we have not run out of food. And for that, we are grateful to you, our supporters. But the possibility is always there, so we do not get complacent.

I send you a heartfelt thank you for helping to make sure God's Pantry Food Bank remains stocked and able to feed more than 160,000 Kentuckians annually.

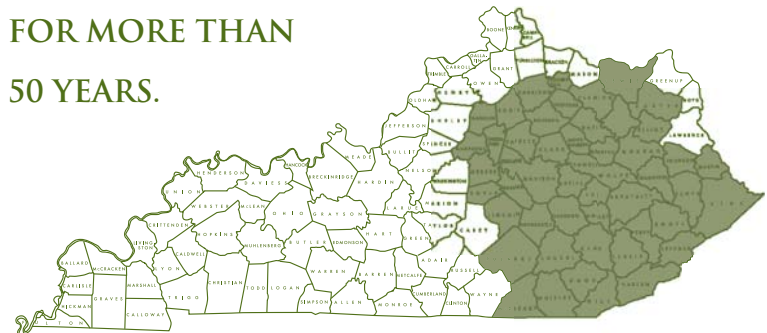

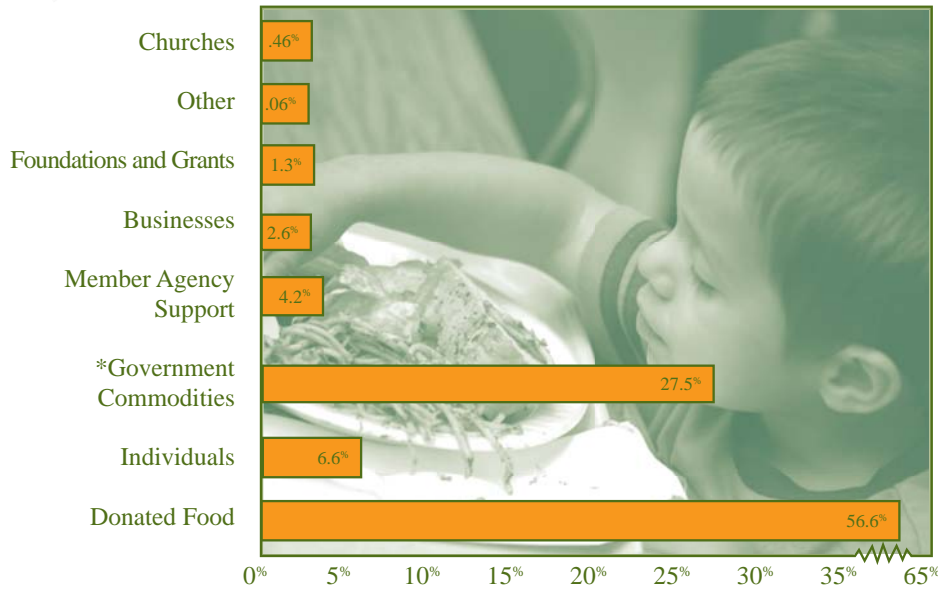

OUR VISION FOR THE FUTURE

God's Pantry Food Bank is committed to reducing hunger in Kentucky and is continually looking for ways to not only improve service to the more than 350 member agencies in our 50-county service area, but also put more food in the hands of those who need it most - the 300,000+ people living at or below the poverty level in this region.



Over the course of the next four years, God's Pantry Food Bank will be working to grow and better serve central and eastern Kentucky through the completion of the following strategic goals:

-  Nearly double the number of individuals currently served and meet the pounds per person in poverty standard established by Feeding America in all counties served.
-  Improve the nutritional quality of food available to all low-income Kentuckians through distribution and educations.
-  Establish God's Pantry Food Bank as a hunger relief leader in Kentucky.

HUNGER IN AMERICA 2009

In the coming months, God's Pantry Food Bank will participate in Hunger in America 2009, a national research study on the issue of domestic hunger done by Feeding America.

This survey, done every four years, provides valuable information to the food bank as we move forward in our strategic planning. This survey tells the food bank:

-  How many people are receiving emergency food assistance from our network of member agencies
-  The household makeup of the clients receiving assistance, including family size, age demographics, occupational information and how these families are making ends meet.

Hunger in America 2009 also surveys the member agencies in each food bank's service area to find out what obstacles or challenges they are facing in providing assistance for their clients.

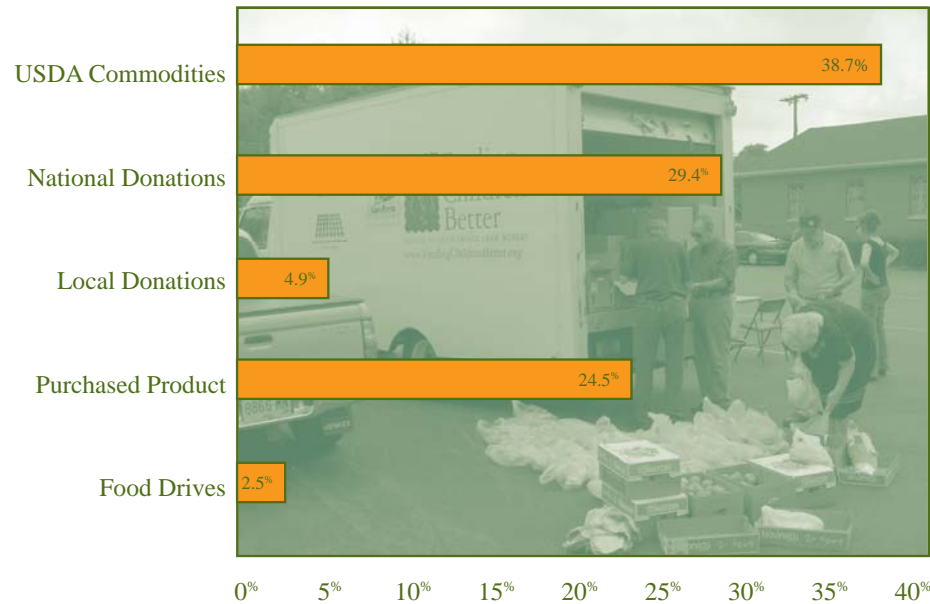
